5. Exhibitors offering their pieces for sale must list the price of the exhibit on the entry form. There will be no commission of sales taken by the Redwood Empire Fair.
6. The exhibit must have a label on the back of the piece stating: The title, exhibitor's name, phone number and price, if exhibit is for sale.

7. The exhibit must be able to be carried by one person.
8. PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD; A special award will be given to the exhibitor chosen by vote of the Fairgoers as the "People's Choice".
9. Greatest care will be taken in handling the exhibits but no responsibility for loss or damage of any kind can be assumed by the Fine Arts Supervisor or the Redwood Empire Fair. The exhibitor must carry any insurance desired on entries.

AMATEUR: Exhibitor who has won no more than 10 blue ribbons or a Best in Show at the Redwood Empire Fair.

ADVANCED: Exhibitor who has won 11 or more blue ribbons at the Redwood Empire Fair.

PROFESSIONAL: Open to all instructors, teachers and professionals.
