#### Rules:

1. All local and State rules apply.
2. No Parking is allowed in front of horse stalls; owners will be towed at their own expense.
3. Approved helmets by American Society for Testing and Materials/Safety Equipment Institute must be worn at all times when exhibitor is handling, riding, leading or driving a horse or pony. Helmet covers or hats made for helmets are allowed.
4. All horses must be checked in at Livestock Office by 4:00 PM Wednesday, August 6.
5. **Ownership or Lease**
  - Horse projects must be owned or leased by and under the exhibitor's care 120 days prior to fair.
  - Horses owned as a joint project may only be shown by one designated exhibitor at an individual show.
  - The official ownership or lease date is the date shown on the receipt of sale or lease unless the animal was bred by the exhibitor.
  - Leased horses cannot be shown for conformation in the halter division.
  - For owned horses, proof of ownership must be available at check in.
  - For leased horses, the lease, signed by the owner and the 4-H, FFA or independent exhibitor, and clear picture or a side view of the horse or some permanent identification is filed at least 120 days prior to the Fair at the county 4-H, FFA office.
  - Drug Testing: Horses are subject to random drug and medication testing specified in the Food and Agricultural Code. The applicable fee is \$5.00 (vs \$3.00 in 2005) per horse per event. The drug testing program is not applicable to most rodeo related competitions, parade horses, and activities under the jurisdiction of the California Horse Racing Board are exempt. Additionally, small single day shows with total fees (includes "entry fees," "stall fees," and other fees), for any single class, that do not exceed \$4.99 are exempt.
6. Tack and gear must be clean, serviceable and safe. Equipment (halters, etc.) should be clean, but silver mounting shall not count in placing. No mechanical hackamores are permitted.

7. Attire: 4-H and FFA uniforms or long sleeved button down white blouse/shirt and dark pants with appropriate boots. English attire for junior horse show can be same or hunt jacket and light colored britches with short sleeved with blouse/shirt, appropriate boots and helmet. No chaps allowed in English or Western classes.
8. A horse 13.2 hands (56.8") and under is considered by AHSA to be ponies. No cross entering. If an animal is entered in a pony class they cannot be shown in a horse class also.
9. Classes not having four or more exhibitors may be combined in age groups.
10. No stallions are permitted.
