Rules:

1. Limit: One entry only in combined market and feeder division.
2. Substitutions may only be made within a division: steer for steer, pig for pig etc. **NO** other substitution will be allowed! Exhibitor's entry may be disqualified for non compliance, such as bringing different species to fair.
3. All market beef must be individually owned by the exhibitor and entered in the auction program for 120 days prior to the weigh-in day of the fair to be eligible for the auction. Independent exhibitors see Junior Livestock Auction Rules #25.
4. No horned Market Beef; must be polled or dehorned, nubbins less than 3 inches will be allowed.
5. Animals that do not meet the minimum weight requirements for market beef may be shown in the feeder class.
6. Minimum scale weights 1,000 pounds. Weight at judging time will show actual weight.
7. Any animal weighing over 1350 pounds will not be sifted, but sale weight will be only 1350 pounds.
8. After weigh-in, market beef will be divided into weight classes within the 1000 to 1350 pound limitation as desired by management for equitability in judging.
9. **Brand inspection certificate from state of origin and bill of sale and transportation slip all three must be presented prior to weigh-in for all market beef.**
10. Fair management may combine classes of (4) or fewer entries. If (4) or less FFA, they will be combined and shown with 4-H market beef.
11. Beef council fee in the amount of \$1.90 will be deducted from the exhibitor's sale.
12. No premiums will be paid on animals sold in the Junior Livestock Auction.
13. As it is the intent of the Division of Fairs and Expositions and of Fairs that the quality standards established for market animals be maintained. Therefore, classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes in Federal Grading.

Rules:

1. Limit: One entry only in combined market and feeder division.
2. Substitutions may only be made within a division: steer for steer, pig for pig etc. **NO** other substitution will be allowed! Exhibitor's entry may be disqualified for non compliance, such as bringing different species to fair.
3. Tail Docking: To qualify for exhibit market lambs must be docked such that the tail (dock) is healed and can be lifted from the exterior. Lambs that have no dock will not be eligible.
4. SCRAPIE: A scrapie ear tag is required on all market and breeding Sheep and Goats. Exhibitors must include this I.D. tag number on their entry form. Scrapie is a fatal, degenerative disease affecting the central nervous system of sheep and goats.
5. All market lambs must be individually owned by the exhibitor and entered in the auction program for 60 days prior to the weigh-in day of the fair to be eligible for the auction. Independent exhibitors see Junior Livestock Auction Rules for Independents.

6. All market lambs must have been slick-shorn at least one week within the weigh-in date, Wednesday, August 5, 2009.
7. Wether lambs should have no retained testicles and will be checked at weigh-in on the Fairgrounds. If evidence of testicles is found, the animal will be disqualified.
8. Animals that do not meet the minimum weight requirements for market lambs may be shown in the feeder class.
9. Minimum scale weights 100 pounds. Weight at judging time will show actual weight.
10. Any animal weighing over 145 pounds will not be sifted, but sale weight will be only 145 pounds.
11. After weigh-in, market lambs will be divided into weight classes within the 100 to 145 pound limitation as desired by management for equitability in judging.
12. Exhibitors must show lambs teeth. Over-age lambs will be disqualified
13. Fair management may combine classes of four (4) or fewer entries. If four (4) or less FFA, they will be combined and shown with 4-H market lambs.
14. The American Lamb Board is collecting funds for promotion, research and consumer information on lamb. The amount of .0050 cents per pound of gross sale weight is to be deducted from exhibitors check for each market lamb sold.
15. No premiums will be paid on animals sold in the Junior Livestock Auction.
16. As it is the intent of the Division of Fairs and Expositions and of Fairs that the quality standards established for market animals be maintained. Therefore, classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes in Federal Grading.

2. Substitutions may only be made within a division: steer for steer, pig for pig etc. **NO** other substitution will be allowed! Exhibitor's entry may be disqualified for non compliance, such as bringing different species to fair.
3. All market Swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor and entered in the auction program for 90 days prior to the weigh-in day of the fair to be eligible for the auction. Independent exhibitors see Junior Livestock Auction Rules for Independents.
4. Animals that do not meet the minimum weight requirements for market Swine may be shown in the feeder class.
5. Minimum scale weights 200 pounds. Weight at judging time will show actual weight.
6. Any animal weighing over 275 pounds will not be sifted, but sale weight will be only 275 pounds.

7. After weigh-in, market Swine will be divided into weight lots within the 200 to 275 pound limitation as desired by management for equitability in judging.
8. 4-H classes will be broken by breed that consists of at least 4 animals of the same breed to justify its own division. FFA and Independent Junior will be broken by weight only.
9. Gilts entered in the market or feeder swine divisions may not be entered in the breeding divisions.
10. The National Pork Board is collecting (1985 federal law) funds for promotion, research and consumer information on pork. The amount of .0040 cents per pound of gross sale weight is to be deducted from exhibitors check for each market hog sold.
11. Fair management may combine classes of (4) or fewer entries. If (4) or less FFA, they will be combined and shown with 4-H market swine.
12. No premiums will be paid on animals sold in the Junior Livestock Auction.
13. As it is the intent of the Division of Fairs and Expositions and of Fairs that the quality standards established for market animals be maintained. Therefore, classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes in Federal Grading.

3. All market Goats must be individually owned by the exhibitor and entered in the auction program for 60 days prior to the weigh-in day of the fair to be eligible for the auction. Independent exhibitors see Junior Livestock Auction rules.
4. All animals in market divisions must be free of horns (naturally polled, dehorned, disbudded or tipped).
5. SCRAPIE: A scrapie ear tag is required on all market and breeding Sheep and Goats. Exhibitors must include this I.D. tag number on their entry form. Scrapie is a fatal, degenerative disease affecting the central nervous system of sheep and goats.
6. Minimum scale weight 60 pounds, maximum weight 125 pounds, will not be paid for poundage beyond 125 pounds.
7. All breeds judged together.
8. Market goats are wethers and does, no bucks allowed.
9. Market Goats must not be over one year of age.
10. Market goats must show milk teeth.
11. Market Goats must be clipped to 3/8 in., hair above the knees and hocks including the head.
12. Animals that do not meet the minimum weight requirements for market goats may be shown in the feeder class.
13. No premiums will be paid on animals sold in the Junior Livestock Auction.
14. It is the intent of the Division of Fairs and Expositions and of Fairs that the quality standards established for market animals be maintained. Therefore, classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes in Federal Grading.
