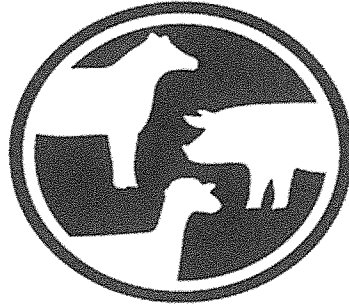
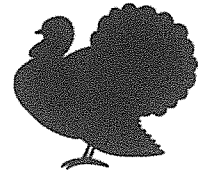

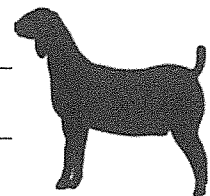

I. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Obtain application prior to deadline: submit complete application and supplemental materials on time and deliver to the Redwood Empire Fair Office on/or prior to April 15, 2022 to:

2. Applicant must complete an oral interview on a date to be set by the scholarship committee.
3. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a club/chapter/Independent and actively participating in the current year's Jr. Livestock Auction at the Redwood Empire Fair.
4. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or be 16 years of age and completed the high school equivalency exam.
5. Applicant must be planning to pursue higher education at one of the following:
 - Junior College
 - 4 Year College or University
 - Trade School
 - Apprentices Program
6. Applicant must submit a personal essay of not more than 500 words to include: Educational experiences that have led you to pursuing a higher education, community service involvement, a little about your family and where you live, your involvement in any and all fields of agriculture and your goals for the future.
7. Applicant must submit all high school/college transcripts. An official high school or Jr. College transcript must be signed/notarized by school official.
8. Applicant must submit two letters of recommendation dated within the last three months (A parent or close relative cannot be considered as a reference). One must be from a teacher or counselor and the second should be from someone who can speak to your Jr. Livestock participation. Each letter must include the name of the applicant, comments on the applicant's character and abilities, an opinion of his/her ability to profit from furthering their education, and the name and occupation of person writing the letter.
9. To be eligible for the scholarship, applicant must have raised, shown, and sold a market animal the year of scholarship application. Recipients of the scholarship will be notified prior to the auction. Applicant must also be prepared to provide proof of enrollment to the school of their choice with follow-up of transcripts showing completion of at least one semester/quarter.
