## 2023 Redwood Empire Fair-Camp Reservation and Wristband Form

- Not following camp rules may result in exhibitor (s) being removed from all fair activities and premiums.
- Aggressive or abusive behavior towards other campers or fair staff will not be tolerated. You may be asked to leave the property and not get your RV until 8/6/2023 after 8 a.m. The Redwood Empire Fair is not responsible for any camper's property.
- Power and water are not guaranteed, bring your RV full of water. Power will be limited and will not run your air conditioner.
- The Community Leader/FFA Advisor who is responsible for all camp occupants must sign all reservation forms.
- Leaders/Advisors are required to supply to the fair office a camp map indicating the location of all families after camp is set up- for emergency purposes.
- Read the attached pages for camp rules or go to redwoodempirefair.com. It is the responsibility of all campers to know these rules.
- The names of every 4-H member, FFA member, Independent junior, chaperones/parents and or younger family members staying in the camp space must be on this camp reservation form.
- Cell phone numbers to reach a responsible adult in case of emergency is required for all spaces (it may be the same number).
- Camp spaces are for campers, trailers, tents or RV's.
- Camp space @ \$120.00 per 15x30 space (larger RV's will require reserving additional spaces) and includes one car pass, \$100.00 per 15X15 tent camping.

## 2023 Redwood Empire Fair

It is the intent of the Fair to provide a safe environment for the Livestock exhibitors and their families during the Fair. The following rules are established to meet the goal.

Please read the camp registration form carefully because it is new.

1. CAMPING IS NOT MANDATORY AND CANNOT BE MADE MANDATORY.
2. NO MOTORIZED GOLF KARTS/SIDE BY SIDES OF ANY TYPE.
3. POWER AND WATER ARE NOT GUARANTEED, PLEASE HAVE RV WATER TANK FULL WHEN YOU ARRIVE. IF AVAILABLE, POWER WOULD BE LIMITED AND WILL NOT RUN AIR CONDITIONERS.
4. NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON FAIR PROPERTY.
5. Campers will line up in the main parking lot of the fairgrounds according to a predetermined schedule provided to each club/chapter prior to fair. Campers enter the main parking lot from State Street.
6. Camp registration/wristband request application forms must be submitted by June 10th, 2023, by 5:00 p.m. Late returns may lose their place in the rotation. Camping is on a first come first serve basis. The Community Leader/FFA Adviser/Adult responsible for campsite must sign all reservation forms. 7. Livestock Exhibitor Campground Camping Fee is \$120 for a 15' X 30' space; also tent camping space of 15' X 15' is available for \$100.
8. All livestock exhibitors, 4-H and FFA Leaders will be provided a discounted Fair entrance wristband for \$10.00, due in conjunction with entry form. A fee of \$10 will be charged for replacing wristband and proof of Livestock exhibitor status will be required.
9. Campsites may setup Sunday, July 30, 2023, between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; if campground applicants exceed space available the Fair may make adjustment in space size or location to accommodate for more spaces. If a RV is bigger than the space purchased there may not be space available for RV. Applications will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. No camping in campsites until Tuesday, August 1, 2023.
10. Camping, R.V., units must be kept within space allocated and not protrude into designated FIRE LANE.
11. Camp packets (wristbands, camp, and parking passes) will be handed out to Leaders/Advisor. If you have any questions or concerns call the Fair at 462-3884 ask for the Entry Department Camping.
12. The only animals allowed past the fence to the campground are service dogs. No other livestock is allowed past the campground fence. Anyone in violation of these rules will be asked to leave the Fairgrounds and forfeit their premiums.
13. Campers are required to use a 12 AWG cord (20 AMPS maximum). Cord must be rated for hard usage and must be free of any defects such as fraying or broken insulation, exposed conductors, or missing ground blade. Cords not meeting these safety requirements will be confiscated. **Cords may not meet in the middle of the road.**
14. No leaking hoses will be allowed; all hoses must be in good repair with proper fittings and washers.
15. Use of generators may be prohibited if exhaust creates a hazard for other campsites.
16. No use of generators after **10pm. NO GENERATORS MAY BE STORED IN HORSE BARN.**
17. No cars, trucks, or vans unless used as a camping unit, will be allowed in the Camp areas except for temporary loading or unloading of equipment. Camp vehicles are to be parked in the designated parking lot at the East end of the camp area. All camping passes must be kept in window of vehicle. All camping wristbands must be worn to identify those that are camping.
18. For the safety of all, fire lanes will be a minimum of 20 feet and are to be kept clear at all times. Any vehicle parked in a camp space, no parking area, or fire lane will be towed at owner's expense. (V.C.22500.1)
19. Camp needs to be vacant by 1pm, Sunday, August 6, 2023.
20. **All pens including breeding, must be clean before leaving fairgrounds.**
17. Vehicles blocking other vehicles, parked in fire lane, or blocking a road will be towed.

## 2023 Redwood Empire Fair

It is the intent of the Fair to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all livestock exhibitors and their families. To ensure a safe and enjoyable fair, it is imperative that all participants are familiar with the rules and their ramifications. By signing and submitting an entry form you acknowledge having read and understood the state and local rules and agree to abide by them.

Particular attention should be given to the Rules for California Fairs 2023, which state, "Fair management shall deny entry or disqualify and remove any exhibit or exhibitor that has violated State and or Local Rules".

The ability to camp at the fair grounds is a privilege. Abuse of this privilege will impact future exhibitors. In addition to the complete list of rules in the premium book, rules mandate the following:

1. NO DOGS
2. NO MOTORIZED CARTS/SIDE BY SIDE/BUGGIES OF ANY SORTS
3. Anyone that is exhibiting under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be held responsible for their actions, which may include removal from the property and all fair activities including the auction.
4. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
5. Alcohol or drug use or possession will not be tolerated.
6. Each camp space must have an adult chaperone over the age of 21 years old staying in the camp space.
7. If a vehicle is parked in the fire lane, a camp space, or no parking area, it will be towed at the owner's expense without notice to vehicle owner.
8. No Swimming Pools or fires.
9. Camping is only for exhibitors, leaders, parents, and chaperons. Siblings will need special permission from the 4-H Community Leader or FFA Advisor.
10. All camping shall be in the assigned camp space, and not protrude into a designated fire lane. Once assigned, a camp space cannot be moved without permission. **When measuring your RV include BUMPER and HITCH**
11. Camp curfew: **11:00PM.**
12. **GENERATOR CURFEW 10:00PM**
13. All visitors must leave the camp area by 11:00 P.M. No visitors are allowed to stay overnight.
14. Exhibitors will not be allowed in the barns past 11:00 P.M.
15. Dogs are not allowed on the fairgrounds, at load in/out or while camping.
16. Registration deadlines will be enforced.
17. Problems should be brought to respective 4-H Club leaders or FFA Chapter advisors first unless an emergency situation exists. If that leader is not able to deal with it, the leader will bring it to the Fair Manager.
18. All fees must be paid with one check from Clubs/Chapters. Independent; cash or cashier check no later than **June 10, 2023.**

The ultimate ramification for failing to abide by the rules is the removal of the exhibitor, the exhibit from the fairgrounds, forfeiture of premiums, and all other awards including possible removal from auction. In order to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all, fair management will remove those exhibitors that show disregard for State and local rules. If a camper/site is asked to leave the RV may not be available to be removed until 8/6/2023 after 8 a.m.. If an RV is left in the field the Redwood Empire Fair will tow it at owners expense.
